Dirty Laundry – An Indian in South Africa explores questions of race, nationality, home, belonging and justice through the lens of an Indian visiting South Africa and meeting those people of Indian origin who have been involved in the anti-apartheid struggle. Some are descendants of the early Indian migrants and indentured laborers in South Africa—a few of whom were represented, in their legal battles with racial injustice, by a young lawyer who would later be called Mahatma Gandhi.
